

# **Boat Trip Down the Mogami River**



Mogami Gorge, which is a course of the boat trip, also known as the place of Oku no Hosomichi, was visited by the Japanese poet Matsuo Bashō. It is registered in the Prefectural Nature Park in Yamagata Prefecture. You can enjoy spectacular seasonal views and listen to a local boat song like 'Mogami Gawa Funa Uta', which the guide sings.

From the boat, you can enjoy a splendid view of the Mogami Gorge, relaxing with the flow of the river. The boat song, which the guides have practiced, as well as their attractive explanations, is one of the main features. You can enjoy the boat ride all year-round with a boat that includes a kotatsu.




# Yoshitsune "Roman" Tour 2

"Roman" means recollections. There is an hour round-trip course riding up Mogami River from Takaya Port through Mogamikyō Furusato Mura and going back to Takaya Port. You'll stop by Sennin dō Shrine, Temple of the Deity of romance, which is related to the Samurai Yoshitsune Minamoto. They have ferries from Takaya Port to Sennin dō Shrine.





#### Refresh Yourself in the "Gensō no Mori"

#### Gensō no Mori 5



It's a mystical forest, where cedar trees naturally grow. These trees are called Shindai Sugi, Tsuchiyu Sugi, Yamanouchi Sugi(cedar) among local people. Judging by the state of the trunk and the branches of the cedars, they are considered to be more than 1000 years old, and they spread in all the directions and into the sky, creating illusionary scenery, just like its name. This area of the woods was registered in the Prefectural Nature Park in Mogami River area of Yamagata Prefecture. It is a very cherished location.

### Map to Gensō no Mori




The natural cedars, which are found around the Mogami Gorge, have the feature of old trees where the trunk is split and twists in many directions like an octopus. The widest one has a 15-meter circumference and you can see cherry trees that have combined with the cedars.

# Tsunokawa no Ōsugi (Big Cedar) 6



It's also called "Nagakura no Ōsugi", which is the big cedar tree in the grounds of the Imakuma Shrine. It has about a 9.7-meter circumference and is about 40 meters high. From the beginning of its establishment in A.C. 724, the cedar has been with this shrine and is said to be more than 1200 years old. Local people worship it as a god tree and this giant, which reaches out to the sky is like a guardian for the district. It was designated as a protected species by Yamagata Prefecture in 1952. It is rare and can only be seen in a few places.






